Animals and Growing (KUW – Science)

Key Vocabulary:

Farm- an area of land used to grow crops or keep animals.

Farmer - a person who works on a farm.

Animals - a group of living things that can move e.g. snake, bird, pig, fish.

Young - a baby animal.

Tractor- a vehicle with big wheels that pulls machinery.

Feed - food for the animals.

Plants - a plant with leaves and roots.
