



Spoken Language: The children will be rehearsing key events before they write.

Writing: The children will be working on using conjunctions, various sentence types and punctuation. This will help us when writing our recount of our trip to the Titanic.

Engage:

The children will be listening to the story of the Titanic and creating a view from a porthole in art. We will also be testing out materials for floating and sinking.

Maths: The children will be learning about position and direction, volume and mass. We will then look at our learning over the year to revise any other topics.

Science: The children will be learning about everyday materials.

PE: The children will be learning about athletics. This will support the children for our sports event at the end of the year.

Year 2 Titanic Topic Overview

Computing: The children will be learning about programming quizzes and using Scratch. This will support the pupils to design a quiz for others using their year 2 knowledge.

History: This half term we will be learning about the maiden voyage of the Titanic and the passengers aboard.

DT: The children will be designing and creating a book with moving parts. We will be investigating levers and sliders before adding them to a Titanic design.

Prove It:

The children will take part in a quiz to show their knowledge of the Titanic.

End of topic showcase: Parents will be invited into school to watch our end of year production.

PSHE: We will use our Jigsaw scheme and our topic will be 'Changing me'.

Music: Mrs Young will be teaching our music sessions.

RE: The RE topic this half term will be ideas of God.

Things to explore with your child!

PE:

Our PE days are Monday and Thursday.

Home Learning:

Home learning – choose one of the projects to do at home and share with the class before the end of term.

Reading:

Our expectation is that children read 3 times a week at home.

They will also read with an adult in school every week. Please use the reading diary to record your reading – this can be a smiley face with the date and title.

Writing:

The children could write a newspaper report about the sinking of the Titanic.

They could also create a timeline of the events of the maiden voyage.

Maths:

Log in to Timestables Rockstars and Numbots using the passwords sent out.

The children could practice talking about directions when out and about.

The children could also practice their measuring when cooking at home.

Science:

When out and about look at what different items are made out of.

Also the children could use water play to find out which materials float and sink.

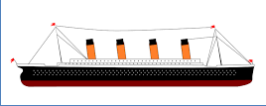
