

## Spoken Language:

Children will discuss the reasons that Greece is such a popular tourist destination due to the legacy of ancient Greece.

## Writing:

Children will complete some creative writing based on Peter Pan and will revisit and edit some earlier pieces of writing.

## Memorable Experience:

Children will enjoy a virtual tour of modern Greece and sketch what they think ancient ruins would have looked like.

### Key Question:

What makes Greece a popular tourist destination?

## Maths:

The children will revisit skills in more depth to prepare them for their transition to secondary school. We will learn time, geometry and revisit several of the number and fraction, decimal and percentage objectives.

## Science:

The children will learn about 'Exhilarating Electricity' and the difference between renewable and non-renewable energy. The children will build on their year 4 knowledge of circuits by constructing series and parallel circuits to perform a variety of functions.

# Greece



## Geography:

Children will complete a geographical enquiry lead by a key question of their choice. They will research an area of Greece with a focus and complete a tourism case study. They will then present this and share their findings on what makes Greece a popular tourist destination in Europe.

## RE:

The children will learn about the concept of ritual in Islam and what makes this significant.

## PE:

The children will improve their stamina and endurance in a range of athletics activities. .

## Spanish:

Children will learn words and phrases for 'in the classroom'.

## Prove It:

The children will use concept hexagons to show links between their learning. They will then show what they have learned in response to the key question.

## Music:

The children will learn the songs for the year 6 production.

## PSHE:

This half-term, children are learning about changes, body image and relationship and sex education.

## Computing:

Children will learn programming using lego.
