

# Things to explore with your child!

**PE:** Our PE days are: Tuesday and Thursday

### Home Learning:

Home learning will be sent home each week – there will be spellings and one other subject area each week. Your child will receive a numbots login.

## Maths:

Practise counting in 1s forwards and backwards from 0-30, then move on to 0-50 or even 0-100.

Practise forming numbers correctly.

# **Reading:**

Our expectation is that every child reads 3 times a week at home. Readingxbooks will be changed on a Thursday. They will also read with an adult in school every week. Please use the reading diary to record your reading – this can be a smiley face with the date and title.

#### **Science:**

Talk about materials at home (e.g. wood, glass, plastic, metal) and why that material may have been chosen.

Talk about and explore waterproof and not waterproof. materials

## Writing:

Ask your child to write about the wolf or Little Red Riding Hood from their story.

Remind them to use phonics – we don't expect things to be spelt correctly at this stage as long as the children are using their sounds when spelling.
